

# SECURITY, EVACUATION & INVACUATION PROCEDURES

## **Fire Evacuation Procedures**

We hold a weekly fire test at 11:00am every Tuesday. Evacuation drills will be carried out twice a year.

If you discover a fire or potential fire situation, break the nearest red break glass alarm or notify Reception. Never put yourself at risk and always maintain a clear escape route.

If the alarm is activated the bells will sound continuously and everyone should evacuate. Remember to close all windows and doors and evacuate by the nearest fire exit. DO NOT use the lift.

All Members are responsible for their own guests and visitors, even when they have been signed in at reception. In the event of an emergency, you must account for the presence of your guests and visitors and report to a member of The Argyll Club team.

**The primary assembly point is on Grosvenor Square, where a you should report to a member of The Argyll Club.**

## **Emergency Invacuation Procedures**

Should the need arise to remain inside the building, our invacuation assembly point is located in the internal staircase.

## **Security**

24-hour CCTV is in operation in various locations throughout the building. The cameras have been installed for your security and protection, and we do not use the recordings for any purpose other than investigating reported Incidents.
