Fire Evacuation Procedures

We hold a weekly fire test at 10:30am every Wednesday. Evacuation drills will be carried out twice a year.

If you discover a fire or potential fire situation, break the nearest red break glass alarm or notify Reception. Never put yourself at risk and always maintain a clear escape route.

If the alarm is activated the bells will sound continuously and everyone should evacuate. Remember to close all windows and doors and evacuate by the nearest fire exit. DO NOT use the lift.

All Members are responsible for their own guests and visitors, even when they have been signed in at reception. In the event of an emergency, you must account for the presence of your guests and visitors and report to a member of The Argyll Club team.

The primary assembly point is at Bishops square at the back of the building. In the event that this cannot be accessed, the secondary assembly point is Spital Square.

Emergency Invacuation Procedures

Should the need arise to remain inside the building, our invacuation assembly point is located in the lounge area on the lower ground floor.
