Fire Evacuation Procedures

We hold a weekly fire test at 4:00pm every Thursday. Evacuation drills will be carried out twice a year. If you discover a fire or potential fire situation, break the nearest red break glass alarm or notify The Argyll Club. Never put yourself at risk and always maintain a clear escape route.

If the alarm is activated the bells will sound continuously and everyone should evacuate. Remember to close all doors and evacuate by the nearest fire exit. DO NOT use the lift.

All Members are responsible for their own guests and visitors, even when they have been signed in at reception. In the event of an emergency, you must account for the presence of your guests and visitors and report to The Argyll Club fire warden.

The primary assembly point is outside the Curzon Cinema. If we are unable to meet there, the secondary assembly point is Leconfield House.

Emergency Invacuation Procedures

Invacuation drills will also be carried out twice a year. In the event of a drill, all members and their guests are to make their way to Reception. DO NOT use the lift.
